COMPETITION RULES

Note: A separate set of rules applies to the *Kathleen Grattan Prize for a Sequence of Poems* and is available to download from the website.

1. Competitions are open to financial and honorary members of IWW.
2. There is a maximum of one entry per member per competition.
3. Entries to be at least one-and-a-half line spacing for prose (fiction / non-fiction) – this is for the ease of reading for judges. Single spacing is permitted for poetry.
4. Entries to be printed on one side of the paper only.
5. Illustrations are not permitted.
6. Entries are to meet or not exceed the word count or time limit as set out in the competition schedule for the entry topic.
7. A completed cover sheet with entry category, title, maximum length as set out in the competition schedule, the actual length of your entry and your pen-name, is to be attached to your entry with either a paper clip or a staple.
8. Your own name must not appear on your entry piece, although your pen-name may appear.
9. Your **real name** and **pen-name** must be completed in the space provided at the bottom of the cover sheet.
10. No writing that has been previously published may be entered.
11. No writing that has won a competition may be entered.
12. No writing that has previously won 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in an IWW competition may be re-entered.
13. Entries are to reach the competition secretary by the deadline, either handed in at the meeting on the due date or to arrive in the post that day.
14. Postal entries are to be sent to International Writer's Workshop, P.O. Box 36652, Northcote, Auckland, 0748.
15. **If you wish your entry to be returned by post, please also include a stamped, self-addressed envelope.**
16. Entries may be emailed in certain circumstances by arrangement with the Competition Secretary whose email address you will find in the newsletter.
